

NSW FLOOD INQUIRY REPORT RELEASED

The long awaited <u>NSW Flood Inquiry Report</u> has been released and we welcome the findings.

Importantly the Report recommends the recognition of the floodplain as an asset (Recommendation 20) and for Indigenous-led community-based approaches to maximise protection for the environment (Recommendation 27).

"That, to maximise protection for the environment in and around floodplains, Government, working with local communities especially Indigenous communities, the NSWRA, other agencies and local councils ensure Indigenous voices are well heard in land use planning and natural resource management "Recommendation 27.

All 28 recommendations in the report have been supported either in full or in principle by the NSW Government.
